STEM CENTRE

Their ultra-modern £4.7million STEM Centre opened in 2017. As well as being home to their Maths department, the STEM Centre is a key teaching and learning venue for Science, Technology and Engineering subjects. There is also a large Mac suite, an open plan study area and Skills Development rooms. The new building was commended by the New Forest National Park Authority in 2019, with leaders calling it an 'excellent piece of modern design'.

Brockenhurst have invested consistently in IT assets to make sure their students always have access to up-to-date learning tools. Many classrooms have undergone significant IT upgrades, including the Business suite, Media rooms, Art rooms and IT & Computing department.
